


These days it seems more often than not, foods are being marketed to promote what they don't contain, rather than what they do.



The avalanche of information, both accurate and inaccurate, that must be navigated on a daily basis, usually online. The large volume of which can make it difficult to extract what is true and relevant.












MDM can be identified as three main forms of informational activity that can cause minor or major harm.

Misinformation refers to false information that is not intended to cause harm.

Disinformation refers to false information that is intended to manipulate, cause damage, or guide people, organizations, and countries in the wrong direction.

Malinformation refers to information that stems from the truth but is often exaggerated in a way that misleads and causes potential harm.



Misinformers' social media accounts have seen a huge follower growth during the pandemic (17). They use these social media platforms as "marketing funnels" to redirect people to their external website where you can find (1,17,18):

- Products to buy (i.e. alternative health products, supplements, programs, books, apparel, videos, movies, docu-series, etc.)
- Paid access to "censored" articles, banned from social media platforms for being misinformation.
- Ads, generating revenues for every visit
- Paid newsletter subscriptions and membership




THIS GRAPHIC LACKS CONTEXT






 Avoid scientific jargon or complex, technical language.

 Well-designed graphs, videos, photos can be helpful to convey complex or statistical information clearly and concisely.

 You must invest effort in translating complicated ideas so they are readily accessible to the target audience—so they can be easily read, easily imagined, and easily recalled.
